I'm both excited and nervous to serve as your 2018 Treatment Committee Chair. It's not required to have been institutionalized to carry the message of Alcoholics Anonymous into a facility. However, as a former patient at a 28-day rehab, I was exposed to the experience, strength, and hope of recovering alcoholics who willingly shared what had been freely given to them. Others planted those seeds. With the guidance of a sponsor and the experience of recovering alcoholics who've been carrying the message into facilities long before alcohol beat the brakes off of me, I started carrying a meeting into the Anuvia Prevention and Recovery Center (formerly Billingsley Detox). That commitment swiftly changed my sobriety and helped me continue to put one foot in front of the other; even on days I didn't want to.

If you have a sponsor, a homegroup, and a year or more of sobriety, join us as we carry the message of AA to someone who may want it. Our committee meeting is held at the Intergroup office every 2nd Saturday of each month from 9:30 - 10:30 am. Carrying the message into some of the dozens of meetings we have taking place each week in the Charlotte area is also a great way for homegroups to be of service too.
