We do this by having a local phone number that anyone can call to get information about the program of Alcoholics Anonymous. This includes the general population, the professional community, and most importantly...the still sick and suffering alcoholic. We also maintain a bookstore and a space for groups to hold A.A. Meetings. In fact, there is an A.A. Meeting every day of the week within the walls of the Metrolina Intergroup Office!
