\*It is required that everyone who participates in H&I panels including those that volunteer from your home group (if your homegroup is in charge of a particular meeting) complete the orientation meeting and sign the required disclosure forms. This is a requirement of the participating facilities, not AA. Thank you for your cooperation and your service.

**\*If you or your homegroup are responsible for taking a meeting into a facility on a certain day/date you CANNOT cancel the meeting. This is not a good look for you, us, or AA as a whole. You should have people that normally go with you that can step in for you. This is very important work as many people we see in these facilities it is their first contact with AA.**
