The sobriety requirements for speaking to groups of professionals are as follows:

- Must have 1+ years of continuous sobriety and worked the 12 steps.
- Must have a sponsor & a home group.
- Regular attendance at CPC/PI committee meetings.
- Observation of one or more speaking events.
- Familiarity with AA Traditions and the CPC/PI workbooks.

The following trends were recorded in December 2024 from our Google Business Profile:

- 56 calls (33% increase from the previous month).
- 23 requests for directions (51% decrease from the previous month).
