* If you or your homegroup are responsible for taking a meeting into a facility, you CANNOT cancel the meeting. It is recommended that you have someone who can cover your commitment in the case that you are unable to do so. If you are having trouble finding a volunteer, please reach out to any of the names on the schedule or myself and Jason. This is very important work, as many people we see in these facilities are experiencing their first contact with AA.
